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WHAT'S THE PROCESS?

After making the decision to educate at home, what are the next steps to follow?

If the student is currently enrolled in public school you must first withdraw by contacting the school's office

Send letter of intent (LOI) Save confirmation email

Keep records of samples of work, field trips and books read

Set up portfolio review or testing close to 1yr. anniversary

Send letter of annual evaluation to the county


